



Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are excited to reopen and serve our members and community once again starting Monday, June 1, 2020! These have been very uncertain times for everyone and we would like to thank you for your patience and understanding. The health and well-being of our members and community is of the utmost importance, and we are happy to welcome you back!

Please ensure you read everything below. We have outlined all new expectations and precautions we are taking to keep our families safe. All information and guidelines are being provided by the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and the Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD).

Locations

Six of our thirteen clubs will be open from 7AM to 6PM Monday through Friday. All fees will be dependent on the open clubhouses, not the rate members of specific clubhouses were paying previously. Payment options will be detailed below. Please review the list of clubs below:

Capacity

Each clubhouse will have a set capacity based on the number of staff in the building and available areas for use, which will cause capacity to fluctuate. If the clubhouse is at capacity, any member trying to enter the building will be turned away. All entry to the clubhouse will be based on a first come, first serve basis. Please do not call and ask to have a spot reserved for your child, we will make no such guarantees.



Fees

All fees are based on the regular fees assigned to each of the six clubhouses. If you need financial assistance, please reach out to the club you wish to attend for more information.

Financial Assistance

Child Care Assistance (CCA): CCA is a program that helps working families with child care fees if they meet the needed requirements. Please see your clubhouse for more information.

Scholarships: Members with existing scholarships approved before COVID-19 will be honored until their expiration date. Please contact your clubhouse if you are unsure about your scholarship status.

Payments

All payments are due upon your child's entry to the clubhouse. Daily fees must be paid for your child to enter the building after they have passed the health screening. Weekly fees must be paid for your child the first day of the week attend, after they have passed the health screening. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!** Payments will be taken by phone or on site at designated drop off locations. **All payments will need to be made via debit/credit card. No cash or checks will be accepted.**

Absolutely NO REFUNDS, regardless of the attendance of your child(ren).

Health Screening

Everyone entering the clubhouse must complete a health screening prior to entry. They will have their temperature taken with a non-contact thermometer and must participate in a health questionnaire. Any person with a temperature over 100.4F or who answered the questionnaire with concerns will be denied entry. They will not be allowed entrance to any Boys and Girls Club location and should return home until they are fever and symptom-free for at least 48hrs and are asked to follow CDC guidelines (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/w019-ncov/if-you-are-sick/end-home-isolation.html>) for being around others: "3 days with no fever AND symptoms improved AND 10 days since symptoms first appeared.

Ratios and Grouping

Program areas will have no more than 10 people at a time; every area will have a maximum of 9 members to 1 staff. Members will be grouped with siblings, regardless of age to (1) limit exposure, (2) improve ability to isolate, and (3) improve ability to track contamination.

Cleaning

Frequently touched surfaces will be sanitized between rotations before a new group rotates into the space. Designated staff will be assigned cleaning/sanitizing responsibilities throughout the day to provide on-going sanitizing of all games, materials, chairs, tables, and doors, and equipment between rotations.



Restrooms

All restrooms will be cleaned after each use and only one member of each gender will be allowed to use the restroom at each time.

Pick-Up and Drop-Off

Parents and/or guardians are not allowed in Clubs. When dropping off your child, please pull up to the designated drop-off area and wait until your child has been cleared through the health screening. If your child does not clear the screening, we will send them back to the car with a note detailing what occurred. Members will only be allowed to enter the club once per day. Once the member has left the building, they will not be allowed to re-enter on the same day. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** When you pick-up your child, please park in the designated pick-up area, call the club and we will send your child out to the vehicle. A staff will escort the child to ensure pick up is by an authorized pick-up contact.

Meals

All six clubs will serve a pre-packaged breakfast and pre-packaged afternoon snack item. Lunch must be brought from home at the time the member enters the building. All lunches and water bottles must be disposable. No lunch boxes or reusable water bottles will be allowed. There will be no sharing of food of any kind, even between family members. There will also be no access to vending machines or selling of snacks or drinks of any kind due to the handling of cash required for those transactions. No outside food from order companies will be allowed for members (ex. GrubHub, DoorDash, pizza delivery, etc.). There will be no use of any microwaves or fridges.

Water

Water fountains will not be used. Members must bring their own disposable water bottles that they can keep on their person.

Health Notice

If a member is feeling ill at any point of the day, they will require immediate pick-up. Members that are ill will be separated from all other members and should return home until they are fever and symptom-free for at least 48hrs and are asked to follow CDC guidelines (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/w019-ncov/if-you-are-sick/end-home-isolation.html>) for being around others: "3 days with no fever AND symptoms improved AND 10 days since symptoms first appeared. Members will not be able to return for at least 48 hours or after being cleared by a physician.

Member Belongings

Members will only be allowed to enter the clubhouse with what is on their person and their lunch/water in a disposable bag/bottle. No backpacks, lunch boxes, reusable water bottles or purses are permitted. No other personal items will be allowed in the clubhouse including tablet and laptops. Members will carry their belongings with them wherever they are, so lunches and water will always be with them .



Staff Practices

- Club Staff must always wear a clean face mask while in the clubhouse.
- Staff will stay 6 feet apart from all members when possible. This will be exempt in an emergency situation that requires immediate first aid.
- Staff will not touch their face.

Member Expectations

- Masks are encouraged, but not required.
- Members will stay 6 feet apart from all other staff and members. Absolutely NO physical contact will be made.
- Members must wash their hands or use hand sanitizer when entering and leaving an area.
- Members must follow directions and stay in assigned areas.
- Members will not touch their face.

Failure to abide by these guidelines will result in an immediate dismissal for the day. If failure to abide by these guidelines continues, it will result in dismissal from the Boys & Girls Clubs of Southern Nevada. The health and safety of our members and community is of the utmost importance. All guidelines and expectations listed here must be followed. The guidelines and procedures listed are not comprehensive, and all final decisions are at the discretion of the Clubhouse and Assistant Clubhouse Director. All guidelines are subject to change at any time. If changes are implemented, notice will be provided.
